Founded in 1886 in Chicago Illinois USA, the Stoelting Company is a manufacturer and supplier of physiological monitoring equipment, including laboratory research equipment, biofeedback equipment, and polygraph instruments. Stoelting entered the polygraph business in 1935 and has pioneered many of the equipment developments in the industry, producing over 16,000 polygraph instruments.

In 1989, Stoelting introduced the first Computerized Polygraph System (CPS) that used a scoring algorithm to help determine a subjects truthfulness. This algorithm was authored by Dr. David Raskin and Dr. John Kircher of the University of Utah, and was based on the results of over 20,000 polygraph examinations performed by the United States Secret Service. Since it's introduction, the CPS polygraph has been widely adapted by domestic and international law enforcement agencies worldwide.


In addition, the CPS is in use by many local police departments and private polygraph examiners in the United States, Canada and worldwide.

The instruments are manufactured in the Stoelting facility in Wood Dale Illinois using quality control standards based on those established by the United States Food and Drug Administration, the agency that regulates biofeedback equipment. No government agency in the United States directly regulates the standards or manufacturing of polygraph instruments.

Stoelting guarantees that the quality of the signal recordings of the instrument are accurate when properly connected to the subject. The final results of a polygraph test is determined only by the skill, experience and training of the polygraph examiner.

Mr. Jose A. Fernandez de Landa was selected as our representative in Europe based on his technical knowledge and his reputation as a highly skilled and honorable polygraph examiner.
